## An Overview of MIA EnviroWise

MIA EnviroWise is the major natural resource management plan for the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area (MIA). The main objective of MIA EnviroWise is to maintain and enhance the sustainability and profitability of the MIA and districts.

MIA EnviroWise benefits our community by ensuring our current standard of living and by protecting the natural and financial resources of the area.

MIA EnviroWise contributes to the sustainability of farming and rural industries, improved biodiversity and the health of our waterways.

## What incentives are available for the community and schools?

As part of MIA EnviroWise, small community groups and schools may be eligible to receive up to \$2,000 in funding for approved projects.

All applications for discretionary funding need to show how their program/project meets the objectives of MIA EnviroWise.

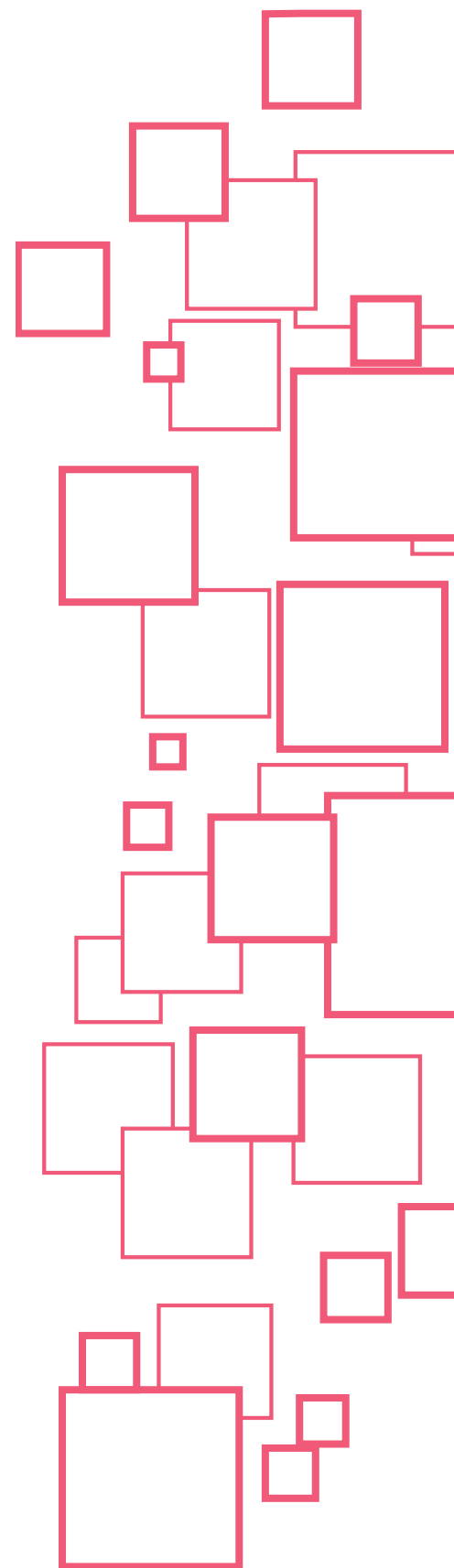
Programs/projects may meet the objectives of MIA EnviroWise by increasing water use efficiency or improving and managing biodiversity in the MIA.

Please note that schools should have a school environmental policy and a copy of that policy should be attached to the application.

All applications should contain a detailed budget/pricing of the project. These can include in-kind contributions and labour charges.

Applications should also state whether the project is ongoing or a one-off. Each project will be granted on an individual basis.
