

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR MURRUMBIDGEE - UPDATE

12 March 2010

State Water's Water Delivery Manager for Murrumbidgee Valley, Ned Hamilton announced today that further periods of access to supplementary water are available (see page 2 for details of supplementary availability). Daily monitoring of the river system has improved our estimated volume and timing of availability of the surplus.

"The supplementary water is a result of inflows from the upstream tributaries in the Tumut and Murrumbidgee River systems, due to rainfall over the last week.

"Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order as normal (a complying water order must have a start meter reading). At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must promptly be phoned or faxed to your Customer Field Officer."

"Failure to supply this information will result in any water extracted being debited from general accounts," Mr Hamilton concluded.

State Water will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide regular updates as more information becomes available.
