LAKE WYANGAN NORTH REOPEN TO USERS

Griffith City Council has reopened Lake Wyangan North after the Lake was closed to all users in February due to high levels of toxic Blue Green Algae.

With the cooler weather, recent rain and rise in the north lake water level, the blue green algae concentrations have declined to satisfactory limits for recreational activities including boating and fishing.

Griffith City Council's General Manager, Peter Brooks and Murrumbidgee Irrigation's Managing Director, Mr Brett Tucker would like to thank all users of Lake Wyangan for their co-operation and patience during the lake closure.

Council's Environment and Health Department will continue to monitor the lake's water quality closely and Council will advise of any changes in the algal status.

Regular users, such as the boat club and sailing club will be formally notified of the reopening of Lake Wyangan North.
