Raveen Jaduram is Chief Operating Officer at Watercare Services Limited. The organisation recently implemented the integration of the bulk and retail water and wastewater service functions for the greater Auckland region. With 650 staff and assets valued at around \$8 billion, it serves 1.4 million people.

Raveen was Chief Executive of Manukau Water Limited between 2006 and 2010. He has held senior management roles at water companies and within councils in Auckland. He has over 24 years of experience within the New Zealand water industry.

With honours and masters degrees in civil engineering from the University of Auckland, Raveen has undertaken a number of post-graduate management studies, including those from Stanford University in California, Macquarie Graduate School of Management, Australia, and the University of Auckland.

Raveen is a trustee of the Watercare Harbour Cleanup Trust. He is also the secretary of the Auckland University Engineers Association.

Raveen is a previous President and Chairman of the New Zealand Water and Wastes Association (now Water New Zealand), and was on its Board between 2001 and 2006.

He was chairman of the water sector Senior Executives Forum between 2005 and 2010. Until its disestablishment in June 2009, Raveen was chairman of the Auckland Water Group, which had undertaken the annual benchmarking for the Auckland water industry.

He has served as the New Zealand Director on the House of Delegates, Water Environment Federation, USA.

Raveen has worked with other technical and not-for-profit groups. He has been on an advisory group of the Ministry of Health on drinking water quality for a number of years. He has served on the management committees of the New Zealand Society on Large Dams and the New Zealand Water Environment Training Academy.

Raveen has special interests in risk and asset management. He has been a guest lecturer teaching this subject to post graduate students since 2001 at University of Auckland.
