Winter Works and 2019 supply interruption

Works updates:

Lake View Branch Canal Expansion Stage 1 (LVBC):

We have replaced the bridge located at the north end of Scotts Road. The bridge widening (from 3 metres to 15 metres) ensures a safer route for the local school bus, as well as regular traffic through this area. At the same location the foundation structure for the new regulator has been installed and is awaiting installation of the new frame and gates. Construction works will commence on the Beltrame and the Leagues Club regulators, as well as demolition of a cross bridge and the bypasses for Noorla bridge over the next week. Stage 1 of the LVBC works will be completed by the end of July.

Mirrool Creek Branch Canal (MCBC):

These works will improve the level of service to customers by fixing performance issues and will increase capacity in the upper pools of the MCBC. Work will commence at the start of July for completion by the end of July. There will be limited supply access on this part of the network until early August.

Warburn Channel Lining: To reduce channel seepage, 1.3km of Lateral 258 will be reshaped and lined with a durable plastic that has a lifespan of up to 50 years. The new lined channels will have different characteristics (e.g. very slippery), and we will be erecting safety fences in key areas. Works will commence at the start of July for completion by the end of August.

Gogelderie Branch Canal (GBC): Works on the GBC to modernise regulators, offtakes and escapes are progressing well. Most of the works are scheduled for completion by the end of July, with some minor delays on one structure due to the welcome rain.

Yanco S&D pumped pipeline system: Stage 2 of the Yanco Stock and Domestic Pipeline project is around the halfway mark, and on schedule to be completed by the end of July. Over the next week there will be a focus on pipe laying, welding and backfilling. Pipes are being installed at road crossings and this will result in some road closures and diversions. Impacted areas include: Edon Street, Jurambula Street, Dallas Street, Bondi Street, Bringan Street, Progress Street, Gidgell Street, Hanwood Street, Short Street and Research Road.

Outlet modernisation program: We are continuing to install new, and upgrading, metered farm outlets to be automation ready. These works are scheduled for completion by the end of July.

The modernisation works, combined with WaterNSW restoration works at Berembled Weir, mean that we are currently maintaining a modified irrigation supply through to mid-August.
