

Gogelderie Branch Canal 2 Automation works



Gogelderie Branch Canal 2 (GBC2) works during the 2019 winter works period involve the automation of structures escapes and offtakes on a section of the GBC2. Automating this section of the GBC2 will improve the level of service for customers and give MI improved flow control and reduce water losses.

Works:

Construction works will commence at the start of June and works will be completed by the end of July 2019.

The works will include:

- Upgrade of regulators with automated gates
- Automating escapes and IHS offtakes, and
- Removal of some regulators and outlets.
