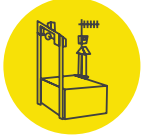
CUSTOMER FACT SHEET

What connection is right for me?

Delivering water to our customers in the best way possible means accounting for every drop and ensuring all water diverted from the MI system is authorised.

We know that our customers have a range of requirements when it comes to accessing the MI water delivery system. From large productive farms through to small home gardens, there is an option to access the MI supply network to ensure you get the water you need, when you want it.

SUPPLY OPTIONS



Metered outlets

You can access our network in a way that suits your requirements through one of six different sized metered outlets, or one that is custom designed to meet your needs.

- Low Flow Meter (0-1 ML/day)
- Small Meter (0-6 ML/day)
- Medium Meter (2-15 ML/day)
- Medium Large Meter (2-30 ML /day)
- Large Meter (2-60ML/day)
- Extra Large Meter (2-100ML/day)
- Custom Meter (>100ML/day)



Residential Connection

The [Residential Connections Program](#) is for customers with water entitlements who require water for use on an area up to 1 Ha. This product is for domestic and/or garden water usage, and only for customers with water entitlements.

Customers with no water entitlements will need to use our Garden Licence product, or purchase water entitlements.



Garden Licence

For domestic garden water usage you can apply for a Garden Licence. The Garden Licence includes options for both 2ML and 4ML of water, the maximum size of the land can be no greater than:

- 1/2 ha for a small HGL (2ML), or
- 1 ha for a large HGL (4ML).

Garden Licence customers are required to supply their own pipe and pump.

You are also able to update or change your connection at any time as needs change and we will work with you to get the solution that suits your supply needs.



Temporary Pumping Permit

If you require water for ad hoc or short term needs, such as harvester washdown or to fill your spray tank, you can apply for a Temporary Pumping Permit to access the channel system to obtain small amounts of water.

To be eligible for a Temporary Pumping Permit you need to use no more than 0.5 Megalitres a season for this purpose.



Tanker fill

Water to fill a tanker direct from our system needs to be paid for in advance.

Once payment is made we will advise on a suitable extraction location. Examples of a tanker fill include for dust suppression for road works, and on farm works.
